Settling In

In my last letter, I asked you to pray about housing and transportation for me as I stay in Ft. Worth. I am living in the Gaudets' house while they are gone. I appreciate them letting me house-sit for them. It makes life convenient since the office is in their home. I am still working on getting a vehicle, but other things have come up that have put that on the hold for a bit.



It was difficult to say goodbye to the rest of the Team, but at the same time there was complete peace that this is God's will and timing. I am enjoying the work here. I have also enjoyed being involved with the Gaudets' home church, Metropolitan Baptist, here in Ft. Worth. They have taken me in as if I were one of their own. I am thankful for their love and help while I'm away from my own home church.

The Work

While the rest of the Team has been getting set up in Thailand and traveling, the work coming to me has been a bit slow. This has been the perfect opportunity for me to get caught up on several tasks that have been needing my attention for some time. I am also using this time to get more training in some of the programs we use.

One of the long-waiting projects I've begun work on is producing a Bible font. We have needed a font we can not only freely use, but also freely distribute. We have permission to use the font we have, but there are some restrictions. As I began learning this process, I quickly realized I was once again in over my head. I ask for your prayers as I learn the process and the programs to create this font. It will take a miracle from God for me to complete this, but He has done such miracles for me before.

I have also been posting additional literature to the Resources For Missions website. This site is a combined effort of missionaries to make their literature available for others to use. While I was working stateside, the Gaudets and I hoped it would open doors for me to travel and do typesetting, troubleshooting, and training in situations where the work couldn't be brought to us. That dream is being realized more quickly than I had anticipated.



I will be leaving October 17 to fly to Apia, Western Samoa, to help Pene & Robyn Faafouina. Robyn is a trained typesetter, but needs further help and training with the new program. I will be staying six weeks. This will give us time for the training, setting up templates, and getting caught up on projects that are waiting. Of course, this should also give time to see some of Samoa and the work there. I am also looking forward to good fellowship with these dear friends. Some of you who have known me a long time may remember that Robyn was with us in Australia in 2000-2001. It will be good to see them again, to see the work God is doing there, and help them in their labors.
