### Typesetting & Training

The work on the Falam Chin songbook for Burma has not moved forward very quickly. The folks scanning the original have not been able to get more scans to me, so I have put that on the back burner until I receive them.

In the meantime, there have not been any large typesetting projects, but numerous small ones. I have helped the Faafouina family update their prayer cards for furlough, helped the Gaudets with their prayer letter until they could get someone trained to use the program needed, and have helped other pastors and missionaries with various projects over the phone or via email. I am so thankful God has given me the training and resources I need to help others in their ministries.



The past couple of weeks I have had Carolyn Chambers staying with me. She is sent out of Grace Independent Baptist Church in Linden, TN and will be going to work with the Gaudets in Thailand. By the time this letter goes out, she will be in Bangkok. She made a two-week detour through Fort Worth so I could train her in InDesign and basic publishing. As the Team in Bangkok has shifted in the last year, they find themselves with experts in many areas, but no one who knows how to use InDesign. Much of the work there uses other software, but there is

a need for someone on the Bangkok Team to know InDesign. Carolyn did well learning the program in the short time she had. God blessed, and we found a resource book that she needed for an excellent price, so she is prepared. She has safely arrived in Bangkok and I know she would appreciate your prayers as she begins her ministry there.

### Travel & Education

I have done a bit of traveling in the last month and there is much more to come in the month of November. A couple of weeks ago I traveled to Temple, Texas to be in the Anniversary service of one of my supporting churches. November 1 will find me on a plane to Alaska. I am scheduled to be in a missions conference, and then I will spend an extra week with my family before flying back to Fort Worth. I will be there for a total of 2 weeks.

When I return to Fort Worth, I will be here for less than a week before going to Amarillo. My church is having a special service before Cheston Furrow, our missionary to Russia, re-

turns to the Field, so my pastor has asked me to be there. I will be there for most of a week before heading to Belton, Texas. November promises to be another busy month.

In my spare time, I have been taking some of the classes offered by Metropolitan's Timothy Endeavor. Even though I have missed a few classes because of my busy schedule, I have enjoyed classes in Romans, the Holy Spirit, Crisis Management, and Music. I thank God for this opportunity to learn more.

### Video and Web

I would much rather typeset than edit video, but, from time to time, the need arises for me to dust off my video tools, dig in my memory for those lessons I learned so long ago, and apply my limited creativity to video editing. This has happened a couple of times these past months.

My good friends, the Faafouinas, are home on furlough from Samoa. They needed to update their ministry presentation as they prepared to begin visiting churches. Sarah Wilson took pity on us and helped with it so we could get it finished in time for them to leave here. I never could have finished it in time without her help, even with Robyn getting everything ready for me.

I am also trying to put together a presentation about this ministry God has given me. In these last few years, I have helped several missionaries with their presentations, and it seemed time to put one together for my ministry. I had hoped to have it finished before my trip to Alaska, but with everything else that has been going on, I did not get it finished.

Thankfully, the work on websites is not so difficult for me. We have added some literature to the Resources for Missions website. There have been a Spanish NT and four Burmese tracts added, as well as updated Thai tracts and their English translations.
